



## Funding History

- To date, CWIFP has received a total of \$81 million for credit subsidy and an additional \$15.4 million for administration of the program. This will allow USACE to **issue up to approximately \$7.5 billion in loans** to projects that are focused on maintaining, upgrading and repairing dams identified in the National Inventory of Dams as being owned by non-federal entities.
