VISITOR INFORMATION

The US Army Corps of Engineers maintains and operates this campground for your enjoyment. Your attention to these guidelines and adherence to these rules and regulations is greatly appreciated. Please feel free to contact one of the park rangers, park attendants or volunteers in the area if you have questions or need assistance. Please report any problems you encounter.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Quiet hours are in effect from **10 p.m. to 6 a.m.**
2. Each campsite is provided two pre-paid vehicle entry hangtags. Additional vehicles or visitors to campers are charged **\$3.00** fee per vehicle.
3. To help prevent the spread of the Emerald Ash Borer and other forest pests, campgrounds may only use firewood that has been certified as heat-treated by U.S. Department of Agriculture or state natural resource agency. The Corps may provide a refund of camping fees within the usual limitations. Visitors burning unapproved firewood will receive warnings or citations.
4. Fireworks are prohibited.
5. **Unlicensed motorized vehicles** are not authorized on project roadways. The use of licensed motorized vehicles on project roadways is for access to and from facilities such as bathhouses, park attendant building, day use areas, etc.
6. Camping units are restricted to **one wheeled unit and one tent**, or **two tents per site**. Tents are allowed to be placed off of designated campsite.
7. A maximum of **six** persons per campsite is allowed. All vehicles and camping equipment must fit on the designated site pad. Vehicles that do not fit on site can be placed in overflow parking lots.
8. Pets **must be on a leash** and dog barking controlled at all times. Continuous dog barking may result in being asked to leave the campground.
9. Gray water must be disposed of in the sewage dump station or sites with sewer hookups. No dumping on or around campsite.
10. Check in and out time is **3:00 p.m.**
11. Camping at one or more campsites for a period longer than 14 days during any 30 consecutive-day period is prohibited.
12. Campsite must be left trash free with all trash disposed of in a designated dumpster upon departure.
13. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Nashville District **Drone Policy** governs the operation and use of recreational unmanned aerial systems (UAS) at all Nashville District lakes within the Cumberland River Basin. The only approved location on Cordell Hull Lake for unmanned aerial systems is Brimstone Recreation area. We appreciate your compliance on this, it helps ensure the privacy, security, and safety for our visitors and the project's infrastructure.
