



Model Feasibility Cost Sharing Agreement For Continuing Authorities Program Projects

Applicability: cost shared feasibility studies for Continuing Authorities Program (CAP) Projects and other non-CAP programmatic authorities that do not require additional authorization to implement a project.

History:

1. New model approved 5 February 2016.
2. 11 May 2016 Updates:
 - a. Deleted option regarding Indian Tribes. No longer require specific acknowledgment of a Tribe's waiver of sovereign immunity.
 - b. Added new option applicable to Section 206 and Section 1135 feasibility studies initiated prior to 2006 and not completed by September 30, 2013.
3. 28 October 2016 Update: For Option 3 (Multiple Sponsors) – added Article on Joint and Several Responsibility.
4. 4 April 2017 Update: Added new Option 6 for converting a feasibility study funded under the Investigations Program to the Continuing Authorities Program.
5. 14 June 2018 Update: Clarified Article IV.A. and Options 1 and 3; added a new Option 7 when the CAP FCSA is used for non-CAP programmatic authorities that do not require additional authorization to implement a project; and provided editorial revisions for consistency with more recently approved models.
6. 5 September 2019 Update: Updated to provided editorial revisions and clarifications.
