


Bal Harbour Beach Renourishment

EVALUATING ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACTS



KEY RESOURCES TO PROTECT

CULTURAL RESOURCES



The project is surveyed for archaeological sites. If found, the resources are protected prior to construction.

RECREATION



Recreational uses such as boating, swimming and beach activities will be considered during the NEPA analysis.

WATER QUALITY



Suspended sediments in the water column are monitored during dredging and beach placement activities.

BEACH WILDLIFE RESOURCES



On the beach, shorebirds and sea turtles are monitored during nesting season.

ESSENTIAL FISH HABITAT



Impacts to seagrass, the water column, hard bottom habitats are evaluated and appropriate protective measures are established.

OTHER BENTHIC RESOURCES



Measures will be implemented to protect hard and soft coral, sponges, and other benthic resources.

THREATENED & ENDANGERED SPECIES



Approved methods to protect threatened or endangered species such as manatees and Johnson's seagrass will be implemented.
