

Trash



Keep area free of trash and litter. Deposit all trash in cans provided prior to departure. Remove refuse from grills. Leave hot coals in grills, do not place in trash cans. Remove all decorations, tape/tacks, etc.

Pets



Pets must be kept on a leash (six feet or less), caged, or physically restrained at all times. Do not place chains around trees. Do not leave pets unattended. Loud and continuous barking will not be tolerated. Cleanup immediately after your pet.

Shelter Use



- When not otherwise reserved, picnic shelters are available on a first come, first served basis. Reservations are posted on the chalkboards next to shelters. Reservations guarantee the shelter all day (6:00 a.m. -10:00 p.m.).
- Replace tables removed from shelters prior to departure.
- A shelter reservation does not include exclusive use of adjacent playgrounds, parking or restroom facilities.
- Shelters at Observation Point and Point Loop in Tuttle Cove campground are not reservable

Special Activities



- Activities which are not normally engaged in by users on a day-to-day basis, impact or restrict use by others, or otherwise significantly impact the park (as determined by Park Rangers) require a special event permit. These activities include, but are not limited to: amplified music, vendor sales (including food), specialized apparatuses (e.g. bounce houses, dunk tanks, rock walls, water slides, etc.), and/or large groups that exceed facility capacity.
- Applications for special events must be requested 30 days in advance.
- A shelter reservation does not authorize special activities.

Availability

When not otherwise reserved, shelters are available on a first come, first served basis. Reservations are available from 15 APR thru 31 OCT.

Booking

Requests are accepted as early as 8:00 a.m., the first business day of the calendar year and as late as 24 hours in advance (4:00 p.m. Friday for weekend reservations). Requests are processed in the order in which they are received.

Payment & Permits

Payment is due upon booking. Shelters cannot be held without payment. Credit/debit accepted (cash/check accepted for in-person requests). A permit is issued upon payment and confirmed upon signature by the holder.



Rules & Regulations

Thank you for choosing Tuttle Creek Lake for your outdoor experience. We hope your visit is safe and enjoyable. The following list of rules are provided to assist you during your stay. Not all rules are listed, for a full list refer to Title 36. A copy of Title 36 is posted on bulletin boards or can be obtained from Park Rangers, or 24/7 from the project office entryway. Questions can be directed to a Park Ranger or the project office.

General Use



1. Outlet Park is open for day use only. Park hours are 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. Visitors found in the park outside these times are subject to fine.
2. There is no fee to use or park in Outlet Park. Vehicle permits are required for River Pond State Park (adjoining eastern boundary of Outlet Park).
3. Stand-alone picnic tables and pedestal grills are available on a first come, first served basis and cannot be reserved. Unattended items will be removed and collected as lost & found.
4. Fires must be confined to grills. Personal grills are permitted. No ground fires! Leave hot coals in park grills—not dumpsters.
5. Roadside directional signage is not permitted.
6. Alcohol is permitted in moderation. No kegs.
7. Fireworks are prohibited at all times.
8. Excessive noise is prohibited at all times
9. Loaded firearms and other projectile firing devices (bows, sling shots, paintball/pellet guns, etc.) are not allowed in the park.

Vehicles



Park in designated spaces only. No parking on grass (or what should be grass) to include roadside edges. Do not obstruct traffic or emergency vehicle access. Parking is limited, encourage your group to car pool.

Speed limits are posted and enforced!
