


RULES & REGULATIONS

- Always wear a DoT-approved helmet while enjoying the Spillway Cycle Area.
- The park is open to bicycles and 2, 3, and 4-wheeled motorized vehicles with a wheelbase under 66 inches.
- Boundaries are posted with signs and barriers. Do not cross Dyer Road or ride on paved roadways, including ditches adjacent to these roads. The park entrance road and parking area are not part of the riding area. No vehicles are permitted anywhere in the spillway channel or canyon.
- Remain on established trails and avoid riding when the trails are muddy.
- All motorized vehicles must be effectively muffled with an unmodified muffler and spark arrester.
- Alcohol and firearms are prohibited in the park.
- Speed limit is 10mph in the parking area.

Those in violation of any of these policies may be cited and/or asked to leave.


Hours:

The Spillway Cycle Area adjoins the spillway just below the east end of Tuttle Creek Dam, with access from Dyer Road.

The Cycle Area comprises 35 acres of open and wooded terrain adjacent to the spillway. Several miles of trails range from **novice-level stretches to expert hill climbs**. Picnic tables, a vault toilet, and a loading ramp adjoin the entrance parking lot.
