MEMORANDUM FOR Commanders, Major Subordinate Commands

SUBJECT: Implementation Guidance for Study and Project Provisions Relating to the Continuing Authorities Program in Title I of the Water Resources Development Act of 2007

1. Purpose. This memorandum addresses provisions of the Water Resources Development Act of 2007 (WRDA 2007) relating to the Continuing Authorities Program (CAP) in Title I of the Act. Guidance for CAP related provisions contained in other Titles of WRDA 2007 will be provided separately.
2. Sections 1002(a)(1) – (40); 1002(b)(2), (4), (8), and (10); 1003(1) – (18); 1004(a)(1) – (21), 1004(b)(2); 1005(1) – (7); 1006(a)(1) – (16), and (18) – (43), 1006(b)(1), (3), and (4); Section 1007; Section 1008; and Section 1009. The studies and projects identified in these sections may be considered for implementation in accordance with the current CAP policy and procedural guidance. Division Commanders will consider the initiation, continuation, or implementation of any of the listed activities based on the availability of funds, compliance with CAP guidance, and their priority relative to other work.
3. Sections 1002(b)(1), (3), (5 – 7), and (9); 1004(b)(1); 1006(a)(17); and 1006(b)(2). The studies and projects identified in these sections include special requirements or direct specific solutions. Specific guidance for these provisions will be provided under separate cover.
