PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice of Office Hours Miami Regulatory Field Offices Jacksonville District – Corps of Engineers

Beginning the week of September 23, 2019, the Miami Regulatory Field Office will be open for public access Monday through Thursday, 8:00 am to 4:00 pm. The offices will be closed to the public on Fridays.

Florida has, and continues to have, an incredible growth rate of approximately 900 new residents per day. This daily increase in residents results in the conversion of approximately 300 acres of vacant land per day into residences, businesses, shops, roads, municipal landfills, and other developments. Approximately 25 percent of Florida's surface area is either open water or wetlands and the majority of these areas are subject to the Corps' regulatory program. This means a considerable portion of this ongoing conversion of land use requires evaluation and/or permits from the Corps. State-wide the Corps' workload has increased from approximately 8,000 applications a year in 1996 to approximately 11,000 applications in 2018. Currently, the Miami office has nearly 500 pending applications but does not have a comparable staffing level.

In order to deal with our continually increasing workload, Fridays will be set aside as quiet days, so that our staff may more efficiently evaluate permit applications, update our database and perform the many other duties required by our regulatory program.

We acknowledge that this action may inconvenience the regulated public, but request your patience, as the Corps continues to administer its regulatory program as efficiently and fair as possible given our heavy workload.
