

Former Ramey Air Force Base



The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has been investigating an undeveloped area within the Rafael Hernández Airport (south of the runways) to determine if there were any environmental impacts to that area attributable to the Department of Defense. We searched two sites, known as Landfill 1 and Suspected Waste Area 2, which were part of the former Ramey Air Force Base. The investigation covered 16.4 acres that the Puerto Rico Port Authority owns. The Corps' investigation and remedial alternative will not change the current or proposed future use of this land.

We recently completed a Remedial Investigation, which is summarized in the Proposed Plan. We will present the plan and the preferred alternative on Tuesday, March 6, 2018, at 6 pm at the Courtyard by Marriott located at West Parade/Belt Road in Aguadilla. The Proposed Plan and other project documents are available for review at the reference desk in the Interamerican University Aguadilla Campus Library. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers invites you to review and comment on the Proposed Plan during the review period.
