A RECURRING REVIEW WAS CONDUCTED AT THE FORMER JEFFERSON BARRACKS POST DUMPING GROUNDS SITE, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Kansas City District (USACE) has completed a recurring review for the former Jefferson Barracks Post Dumping Grounds Military Munitions Response Program Site. The Jefferson Barracks was established in 1826 as a garrison for the U.S. Army infantry units. From 1826 to 1946, portions of the Jefferson Barracks riverfront property were used for various waste disposal activities, including World War I-era military munitions, such as mortar rounds. The approximately 10-acre area on the Mississippi River water front is now referred to as the former Jefferson Barracks Post Dumping Grounds. The selected response action for the Site, which was implemented in 1999, includes land use controls consisting of the installation of riprap (stone or crushed rock, which is placed along shorelines to protect against erosion), posting of warning signs and a deed restriction to provide notice to future owners that military munitions are located on the property.

What is the purpose of a recurring review?

The purpose of a recurring review is to determine if the response action is protecting human health and the environment. The recurring review report documents the methods, findings, conclusions and any recommendations of the review which also includes a visual site inspection of the land use controls in place.

What are the conclusions of the recurring review?

This recurring review found that the response actions continue to be protective of human health and the environment by preventing unauthorized public access to potential unexploded ordnance. Conclusions of the report consist of completing all necessary inspections, maintenance of degrading warning signs, and conducting another topographic survey. The next review is scheduled for 2019, and beginning in 2015, the project will transition to the remedial response process in order to achieve a final remedy.
