

SUBJECT: DMMP RECENCY EXTENSION FOR DREDGING AT THE OLYMPIA YACHT CLUB.

1. A DMMP suitability determination was issued on November 20, 2012, covering 16,241 cubic yards of proposed maintenance dredged material from Olympia Yacht Club (DMMP, 2012). Of this volume, 9,349 cubic yards were found suitable for placement at the Anderson-Ketron open-water disposal site. The remainder was found unsuitable and will be transported to the Weyerhaeuser Regional Landfill in Cowlitz County for disposal. Being in a high-ranked area, a 2-year recency period was provided in the suitability determination, ending December 20, 2013.
2. Dredging is scheduled to begin November 15, 2013 and to be completed in January 2014. Olympia Yacht Club requested an extension of the recency period to enable completion of the dredging within the this period.
3. There have been no known spill events or changed conditions in the project area since the original suitability determination was issued. The DMMP agencies were consulted and are in agreement that extension of the recency period to January 31, 2014 is acceptable.
